Along with its great visibility to Route 30, the center benefits from a demographic area that includes top manufacturers in York County such as Target, Starbucks, Harley Davidson, and Johnson Controls all with substantial distribution centers along I-83 just a few short miles away, as well as a new 220,000 square-foot hospital for Memorial Hospital, which opened in August of 2019.





TRADE AREA

Adding to the stability of the project, West Manchester Town Center shows a 20-minute drive time demographic of over 333,593 people with household incomes of more than \$74,884 and daytime employment demographics equally as strong with 161,297. The demographics within a 10-mile radius include 259,929 people in 102,667 homes, a labor force of 138,280 with an average household income of \$74,885. The area's growth since 2000 has increased over 15.8% with over 16,247 new homes.



Households in York County, PA have a median annual income of \$65,239, which is more than the median annual income of \$61,937 across the entire United States. This is in comparison to a median income of \$63,519 in 2017, which represents a 2.71% annual growth.

TOP COLLEGES

In 2017, universities in York County, PA awarded 2,284 degrees. The student population of York County, PA is skewed towards women, with 3,092 male students and 3,910 female students. The largest universities in York County, PA by number of degrees awarded are York College of Pennsylvania (1,014 and 44.4%), YTI Career Institute-York (686 and 30%), and York County School of Technology-Adult & Continuing Education (214 and 9.37%). The most popular majors in York County, PA are Dental Assisting (129 and 5.65%), Other Practical Nursing, Vocational Nursing, & Nursing Assistants (118 and 5.17%), and Registered Nursing (99 and 4.33%).

The median tuition costs in York County, PA are \$17,560 for private four year colleges, and \$13,484 and \$21,402 respectively, for public four year colleges for in-state students and out-of-state students.






